

Bring A Friend Week FAQs

1. Can my child bring more than one friend? **YES!**
2. My child is in multiple classes; can their friend go to more than one class? **YES!**
3. If my friend doesn't have dance attire, what should they wear? **A fitted T-shirt, leggings + socks (hair pulled back). We have several pairs of ballet shoes that your friend can borrow as well.**
4. What shoes should my child wear for TAP? **Dress shoes, Jazz shoes or clean sneakers. (We also have an assortment of tap shoes that your child can borrow).**
5. If my friend is younger than the age requirement for the class, can they still come? **No; we will uphold the minimum age requirements for group classes. However, they are welcome to attend any class in their age group as a guest during BAFW.**
6. If my friend is unable to attend, can they come a different week for a free class? **No; Bring A Friend Week is one week only. If they would like to come a different week, they would be required to pay a drop in fee.**
7. My friend loved the class and wants to sign up. How do we each get the tuition discount? **Once your friend registers online, you will both be emailed a promo code for your Winter 2025 registration for next semester. Your friend must register by October 14th for you to each be sent the promotional code.**
8. **My child is currently enrolled at Petit Allegro;** can they try out a new class as a guest to see if they'd like to join? **YES; as long as they are in the correct age bracket/level.**
9. **My child is currently enrolled at Petit Allegro in Ballet and Jazz and is interested in trying Tap during BAFW.** Is the \$99 "Add Tap" promotion still going on? **YES! (See Question 4 above).**
10. I saw BAFW online / through a different group but I don't know anyone at the studio. Can my child still try out a class during BAFW? **Absolutely; all we need is a waiver filled out before class. You can print the waiver located at the bottom of our Register tab on our website.**
